Addition Ideas for parents

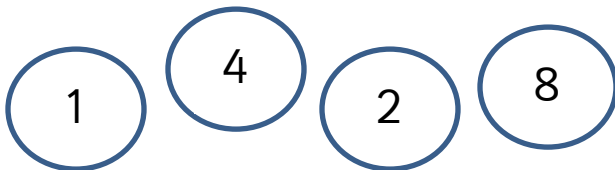


- When working with your child practically encourage touch counting as this will help accuracy.
- Math Mountains will help your child with their number facts to help them become more confident when bridging to the nearest 10 e.g. $8 + 4 = 12$

<p>Addition on a number track</p>	<p>Addition on a number line- placing objects</p>	<p>Addition on a number line- drawing pictures</p>
<p>Addition on a number line- jumps</p>	<p>Addition on a number line- bridging to the nearest 10</p>	<p>Addition on a number line- unstructured</p>

Example activities to play at home with your child:

Pick a pair

Pick a different pair of numbers. Write the numbers and the answer.

Find two dice to roll yourself. Add the numbers that are on the top. What other totals could you get if you roll the dice again?
